Permits & Approvals Required

The following permits and approvals are required for your project. This listing may not be inclusive, and other permits and approvals (e.g., electrical, mechanical, plumbing, etc.) may be required. Please contact appropriate agencies to determine additional permit and approval requirements.

- Entrance/Drainage Permit – contact Engineering Department, City of Bardstown, City Hall, 348-5947
- For new driveway off of state road, State Entrance Permit – contact Highway Department, 348-3448
- Zoning Compliance Permit – see below
- Building Permit/Inspection (building, electrical & mechanical) – contact Code Enforcement, 115 E. Stephen Foster, 348-1862
- Plumbing Permit/Inspection – contact Plumbing Inspector, 349-1310

Zoning Compliance Permit Requirements

The following documentation and fees must be submitted:

- Building & Zoning Compliance Permit application, completed and signed;
- Copy of deed or plat/survey;
- Plot plan, drawn to scale and showing the following information: lot/tract dimensions, location and dimensions of all proposed and existing buildings and structures, driveways, parking, sidewalks, and open space and distances of all structures from front, side, and rear property lines (sample is available for reference);
- Copy of approved City Entrance/Drainage Permit;
- For new driveway off of state road, copy of State Entrance Permit;
- If double-wide manufactured home, copy of manufactured home installer's certification and evidence of year, make, and model and B1 seal or HUD label;
- Copy of approved Variance and/or Conditional Use Permit (if applicable); and,
- Zoning Compliance Permit review fee (payable to Planning Commission).

Upon issuance of Zoning Compliance Permit, please take copy of the Zoning Compliance Permit to Nelson County Code Enforcement to complete the permitting process.

Late Fee Notice:

A late or “after the fact” fee will be assessed for any work started without the required approval and/or permit and for altering, amending, or revising an approved project without prior approval.
